## Single Malt Scotch Whisky

*Speyside*

Glenfiddich 12 yo

\$10

The Glenfiddich distillery was hand built by William Grant and his nine children. Each cask at Glenfiddich is individually tended by a team of Coopers. This 12 year old is matured in American bourbon and Spanish oloroso sherry oak. It presents a fruity nose and a palate of elegant oak and pear characteristics.

The Glenlivet 18 yo

The Glenlivet distiller's philosophy is that nothing should be rushed, everything takes time and attention. There is a drier oak influence here, presenting oak on the nose combined with floral attributes. The palate commences with bitter orange and finishes with sweet spices, butterscotch and toffee.

*Highland*

This small distillery was founded in 1794 and uses only two pot stills. So influential was this distillery that an entire town grew around it. This scotch is aged in sherry casks and presents a rich and smooth styling with caramel and peaty characteristics.

Glenmorangie 'The Quinta Ruban'

The Quinta Ruban begins its life with 10 years maturation in American white oak then is transferred into port barrels from the wine estates of Portugal known as Quintas from which the scotch takes its name. A dark chocolate and mint nose is initially apparent which then settles into a long dark chocolate and orange finish.

Glenmorangie Nectar d'Or

What makes Glenmorangie scotches special is the use of unique oak barrels. The Nectar D'Or is aged for 12 years in hand selected Sauternes barrels from France. As a result the scotch presents with a rich and spicy dessert like quality with honey, nutmeg and a touch of lemon. There is a finish of white chocolate and vanilla, with the initial spice lingering.

*Lowland*

Situated in East Lothian which is 15 miles from Edinburgh this distillery is one of only three remaining lowland distilleries in Scotland. Using local grains the 12 year old is light and delicate with lemon and grassy aspects on nose and palate.

## Single Malt Scotch Whisky Continued

Ardbeg 10 yo *Islay*  
\$15  
The Ardbeg distillers suggest there is a sea spray aspect to all their scotches given that their distillery is situated on Islay and island off the coast of Scotland. This island was used as a smuggling point many years ago, however today houses the Ardbeg distillery. The 10 year old is presenting defined peaty and smoky characteristics with dark chocolate on first taste with a liquorice and coffee finish.

Highland Park 18 yo *Island*

An Orcadian distillery, Highland Park was founded by a smuggler and illicit distiller in the 18<sup>th</sup> century, a man reputed to have disguised casks of scotch as coffins, and distillers as mourners on inspection by the authorities. This is a rich and full scotch, all toffee, almonds and smoke on the nose, which continues right through to the finish.

Woodford Reserve Bourbon Whiskey \$15  
An artisan producer creates the Woodford Reserve in small batches where each bottle is numbered. The distillers at Woodford use a unique grain recipe which sees extra rye being included and that means extra spice in the bourbon. An aquaduct that runs under the property provides pure water bought up from the limestone depths and used to create what the distillers refer to as purer bourbon. Charred barrels are made on site and offer the bourbon a smoky feel.

Hudson Manhattan Rye \$20  
The Hudson distillery opened in 2005 and was one of the first to do so post distilling prohibition which only ended in the mid-nineties in New York. The distillers are self-taught with an ethos founded on classic French cognac production and modern distilling techniques. They have a penchant for locally sourced grain and creating batches that are never the same from one batch to the next. Young wood is used to barrel and this presents a sappy quality and light smoky feel to the 100% rye mash bourbon.

Cascade Brewing Company – Hobart, Tasmania  
A light Australian lager with a distinct spicy flavour and dry finish.
- Rogers Beer \$8  
Little Creatures Brewing Company – Fremantle, Western Australia  
Locally brewed mid-strength amber ale. Aromas of roasted malt, caramel and bitter hops though crisp clean with a subtle bitter finish.
- James Boags Premium Lager \$9  
J. Boag & Son Brewing – Launceston, Tasmania  
In the style of a European Pale lager with aromas of sweet malt and very lightly hopped. Malty with a subtle bitterness. Finishing with a pleasant dryness.
- Two Birds Golden Ale \$10  
Two Birds – Southern Bay, Geelong Victoria  
Brewed using ale, wheat and Vienna malts by two lovely ladies. This ale is bittered with New Zealand Southern Cross hops while Motueka with Australian Summer hops are used for aroma. Motueka contributes melon and citrus aromas and flavours, while Summer contributes spice and apricot notes.
- Moo Brew Pilsner \$15  
Moo Brew – Moorilla, Tasmania  
Adorned in the spirit of John Kelly's iconoclastic "Alien", Moo Brew Pilsner redefines the classic lager, challenging the cherished belief that Pilsners can only be made in Pilsen. This unpasteurised Pilsner is a product of Tasmania's perfect climate however it departs from tradition by using noble German Spalt hops to achieve its unique aroma and lingering bitterness.
- Kooinda Black IPA \$10  
Kooinda Brewery - Melbourne, Victoria  
This hand crafted & unfiltered ale is a new world beer which is beautifully balanced. It uses dehusked malt to provide its black colour & is combined with six specialty malts to provide a black beer with the body and flavour of a traditional India Pale Ale. The predominant hop aroma is provided by late additions of hops in the kettle and dry hopping for 7 days. A beer for the biggest of hop heads.

Sapporo Breweries – Sapporo Japan  
Sapporo, the oldest beer brand in Japan, was first brewed in Sapporo, Japan in 1876 by the German-trained brewer Seibei Nakagawa. A crisp beer with a clean taste.

Chimay 2011 Blue \$16  
Chimay Pères Trappistes – Baileux, Belgium  
A dark Trappist beer with a powerful aroma and complex flavour. It was first brewed as a Christmas beer, explaining the presence of a "vintage". This authentic Belgian beer, whose tinge of fresh yeast is associated with a light rosy flowery touch, is particularly pleasant. Its aroma, perceived as one enjoys it, only accents the delightful sensations revealed by the odour, all revealing a light but agreeable caramelized note.

## Cider

Aspall Suffolk Cyder \$11  
The Cyder House - Aspall Suffolk England  
The Chevallier family has lived at Aspall Hall Farm in the parish of Aspall in Suffolk, England since 1702. In 1725, Clement Chevallier inherited Aspall from his cousin and set about making cyder. Today, the business is owned and managed by the eighth generation of the Chevallier family. Floral appley aroma with a lovely mouth filling mousse and a delicate flavour of fresh pressed apples this is an off dry cyder with a complexity that enhances its long finish, making it an ideal aperitif.

Poire Williams, a pear brandy liqueur, Grand Marnier, a blend of cognacs with bitter orange and pear nectar all over ice. This drink is all about pear!

Apple Martini                  Vodka, apple schnapps and lime                  \$20  
Refreshingly crisp with a hint of sourness. This is the best Granny Smith apple you have had in a drink, just what the doctor ordered!

Fluffy Duck                  Advocaat, crème de cacao and lemonade                  \$20  
Creamy advocaat with subtle hints of chocolate and topped with lemonade. Straight out of the 80's with all the fluffiness of a taffeta bridesmaid dress.

Gin Smash                  Gin, oranges and mint                  \$20  
Fresh oranges smashed together with sugar and mint, topped up with gin over ice. The perfect start to a warm summers evening.

Seppeltsfield is a culmination 150 years of experience in grape growing, wine making and fortified production. There is an attention to detail from the small oak barrels used to the use of only the best and ripest of the brown Muscat grapes. Fruity, raisin filled and floral.
- Seppeltsfield 'Grand' Tokay Rutherglen, Vic \$10  
The Seppeltsfield family are known for their selection of only the ripest fruit for their creation of their fortifieds. This tokay made from Muscadelle presents toffee, honey and a floral style.
- Pertaringa Vineyards 'The Full Front' 20yo Frontignac McLaren Vale, SA \$10  
Made in the McLaren Vale, this 20 year old frontignac is known as 'The Full Front' because of the full frontal assault of fruit and spice to your senses. Frontignac is also known as Muscat Blanc a Petit Grains reputed to be the oldest recognised species of grape vine.
- Kalleske 'JMK' Shiraz Barossa Valley, SA \$12  
This fortified Shiraz is a tribute to John Kalleske who has tended the Shiraz vines from which this port is made for over 50 years. The vines are hand pruned and grape is hand harvested. Young and old brandy spirits are used and the port is aged in matured hogs heads for two years before bottling. Cloves, cinnamon and plums are in abundance.
- Seppeltsfield Para Grand 10yo Tawny Seppeltsfield, SA \$9  
Named after the Para River which provides such an influence over the Grenache, Shiraz and Mourvedre grape Seppeltsfield grows for the production of this tawny style port. There is a defined vanilla oak and rich fruit characteristic to the port.

Pedro Ximenez or PX as it is affectionately known as is like drinking a Christmas pudding, full of fruit, spice and brown sugar. It gets this way because the grapes are picked, racked and left in the sun for two weeks post harvesting. Produced in Spain, southwest of Andalucia in the heart of sherry producing country. Thick, syrupy and raisin like.

2006 Quinta Vale D. Maria LBV Douro, Portugal \$12  
Situated in the Rio Torte Valley of Douro Portugal, Quinta D'Maria is a terraced vineyard operated by three lady wine makers who have a passion for handpicked grapes, handmade and serious wines. The late bottled vintage has aged in barrels before being bottled and this offers the port rich, velvety and fruity characteristics. This is a serious port, not candied or cloying, but worth sitting and mulling over for a while.

Warre's Otima 20yo Tawny Douro, Portugal \$14  
This port is for a young man who'd like to drink like an old man. Warres was established in 1670 as the first British port house in Douro, Portugal. The Otima has seen a modern twist on a timeless classic, with a clean, light and well balanced design. The Otima has taken tawny port from cigar smoke filled and high back chaired drawing rooms to skinny legged jeans and short skirts at an exclusive shindig.

Camus VSOP \$12  
Five generations of cognac production lend well to this Cognac skilfully blended from eau de vie sourced from different areas of the cognac region. Vanilla, clove and stewed stone fruit can be found on the nose with a slightly sweet yet spicy palate.

Paul Giraud Vieille Réserve-Grande Champagne 25YO \$23  
Handed down from father to son, Giraud pick from the 1er Cru Cognac growing areas of the Grande Champagne region. The Cognac is aged for 25 years and is a pure vintage Cognac. Flowers, peach and spiciness await the senses.

Hennessey 'Paradis' \$40  
Founded by an Irishman in 1765 and now one of the most elite names synonymous with Cognac production, Hennessey make the Paradis from some of the rarest eau de vie in France. Spicy and peppery yet floral, this Cognac presents a full bodied and lasting palate structure. The Paradis is reported as being a majestic Cognac that makes many a bucket list.

## Armagnac

Chabot XO Superior Armagnac \$18  
Located in the heart Gascony, Chabot has Moorish, Celtic and Roman origins. This Armagnac starts brown sugary sweet then moves into a walnut, nougat and smoky finish.

Delord 1979 Armagnac-Téna rève \$25  
Brought to you from the undulating hillsides of a small region in the South of France, this Armagnac is made from a short distillation period of November through to December. The nose presents fig and toffee characteristics with a palate that is creamy and full, with a long after taste. Each bottle is hand sealed and it has been this way since 1893.

Castarede 1978 Grand Bas Armagnac \$35  
Castarede is the oldest Armagnac trading house in France and derive the deep amber colour of their Armagnac from aging in old black oak sourced from the Monlesun Forrest. Peach and vanilla are evident from start to the long finish.

## Calvados

### Berneroy Fine

Calvados is also known as apple brandy. At Berneroy the lawn around the base of their apple trees is carefully tended so that the apples have something soft to fall onto as they ripen and fall off the tree signalling their readiness to be included in Calvados production. There is a minimum of two years oak which presents a light oaky feel, with ripe apple and cinnamon cloves on nose and palate.

### 1997 Victor Gontier Domfrontais

The year 1997 was important for Calvados as it was the year that the Domfrontais appellation was created. This 1997 Calvados set the benchmark for future Domfrontais production. Made of 30% pear as well as apple, there is a blend of fruit that presents a range of sweet to tart flavours that is carefully blended to create a more feminine style Calvados. Tarte Tatin flavours abound in this Domfrontais.

## Eau de Vie

### Pere Bertrand Orange Liqueur and Fine D'Alsace

Made in Alsace, France this digestive is a fruit brandy distilled from the dried peel of sweet and bitter oranges. There is a beautiful orange blossom nose and well balanced sweet and tart orange palate.

### Etienne Brana Poire William

Situated in the heart of the Basque winemaking region, Brana is perched on the top of a hill overlooking the Williams pears of their own orchards. There is a fresh and pure aspect to this eau de vie, and this is delivered with an intense pear fruit flavour.
